## WHAT DO WE HAVE?

More women in political office but not nearly enough, woefully inadequate funding for gender equality, shrinking civic space, attacks on women in politics.

## WHAT DO WE WANT!

Effectively use temporary special measures to bring more women into politics; sanction political parties that do not comply. Significantly scale up

resources for gender equality action plans and scrutinize public budgeting so that all investments work for gender equality. Empower women's rights organizations to demand that decisionmakers act on their commitments.
